Minutes

Mr Lloyd informed councillors that the Planning Application for the proposed rebuilding of a shepherds hut at the Dingle, Gwernybwllch had been approved by Herefordshire Council with the following conditions: " to be used as a field shelter and agricultural storage only, unless otherwise agreed in writing with the local planning authority..... to ensure that the development will not facilitate an intensification in farming operations on the site which would be liable to give rise to environmental impacts" and " at no time should any external lighting, except low power, warm LED lighting in directional down-lighting luminaries on motion operated and time-limited switches be installed..... And no permanently illuminated overnight external lighting should be operated at any time without the written approval of this local planning authority."

Mr Lloyd also informed councillors that a date had still not been set for the Planning Committee to hear the two Haygrove planning applications for the siting of 18 static caravans with two water treatment plants, and an extension of the area covered by polytunnels. Mr Lloyd had spoken with County councillor Mr Terry James who thought that the applications would not be heard until after the council elections on May 4th 2023.

Mr Lloyd gave Parish councillors Nomination packs with reference to the forthcoming Parish election on 4th May.

Parish councillors completed the Nomination papers, and Mr Lloyd would deliver them to Herefordshire Council offices at Hereford Town Hall.

Cheques were signed by councillors - £20.00 HMRC PAYE re clerks salary, and £253.76 payable to Mr M Lloyd - £80.00 net salary, £153.76 Website maintenance.

There being no other business the meeting closed at 8.45pm
