Minutes

Aplogies were received from Mr G Meakins and Mr G Steel

Minutes of the Annual General Meeting held on 10th May 2023 were read and approved. There were no matters arising.

Mr Lloyd confirmed that all Parish Councillors had been re-elected without the need for an election.

Parish Councillors signed the Acceptance of Office Returns.

Presentation of Accounts

Mr Lloyd presented the Accounts for the year ended 31st March 2023:- Annual Precept received £750.00; Expenditure - Insurance £247.40, Clerks salary £100.00, Website costs £173.76, Bank charges £99.00 - total expenditure £620.16. This leaves an excess of income over expenditure of £129.84. The Opening HSBC Bank at 1st April was £1364.77, adding the excess income of expenditure of £129.84 gives a Closing Bank Balance of £1494.61.

Mr B James proposed that the Accounts should be adopted as a true and accurate account of the transactions of the Parish Council for the year ended 31st March 2023. Seconded by Mr G Jones and carried. Minute reference ACCST23.

Mr B James proposed that the AGAR 2022/23 Form 2PM should be signed as being true and correct. Seconded by Mr P Williams and carried. Minute reference AGAR23. The Committee considered the Annual Governance Statement for 2023. Mr G Jones proposed that the statement was true and accurate, seconded by Mr B James and carried. Minute reference ANNGOV23.

Elections

MR G Jones proposed that Mr B James should remain as Chair Person of the Parish Council, Seconded by Mr P Williams and carried. Mr B James accepted the proposal to remain as Chair.

Mr B James proposed that the Vice Chair and Committee should remain the same. Seconded by Mr P Williams and carried.

Mr B James proposed that Mr MA Lloyd remain as Parish Clerk, seconded by Mr P Wiliiams and carried. Mr Lloyd accepted the proposal, and he would continue to look for a replacement Clerk.
