

Huntington Parish Council
General meeting 30th November 2022

Minutes

Present: MR BH James, Mr G Jones, Mr G Meakins, Mr G Steel, Mr M Lloyd.

Minutes of the meeting held on 7th November 2022 were read and approved.

Matters arising: Mr Lloyd had emailed Herefordshire Council stating the Parish Councils concerns regarding the planning application for the proposed rebuilding of a shepherds hut in the Dingle near to Gwernybwllch, Huntington.

Mr Lloyd informed councillors that he had sent an Enforcement Complaint to Herefordshire Council concerning the removal of static caravens sited on land near to Lower House Farm.

Mr Lloyd stated that he had forwarded the Parish Councils Annual Precept form for 2023/24 to Herefordshire Council.

Planning Application for Haygrove.

A planning application had been received from Haygrove Fruit Limited to instal two treatment plants, one of which is retrospective.

The Parish councillors discussed the application in detail and Mr G Steel reminded councillors that one treatment plant had already been instaled in July 2022 without planning permission.

Mr B James comented that he was concerned with the amount of water which would used by in excess of 130 occupants. The village had disruptions in water supply this Summer, and water tankers were seen on a number of occasions topping up the reservoir by Grove Farm. Mr James felt that the two water treatment plants would put considerable pressure on the village water supply. Mr James propsed that the Parish Council object to the planning application due to the pressure it would put on the mains water supply. Seconded by Mr G Jones and carried unanimously.

There being no other business the meeting closed at 8.45pm..
